



Manchester Grade Exams – 29th/30th June 2019

Dear Teachers and Dancers,

We would like to invite you to Grade Exams hosted by The Grace Kennedy School on the weekend of 29th & 30th June 2019 in Manchester.

As you will be aware since January 2018 it has been a requirement of CLRG that all 12 Grade Examinations must be completed to be eligible to apply for the TCRG Examination. Therefore we encourage early entry as spaces are limited.

Dancers are permitted to take up to 3 consecutive Grades at one exam and a time period of **3 calendar months** must have elapsed between exams (i.e. the candidates last exam must have been on or before 29th/30th March 2019)

Our exams this year will be held in Altrincham Town Centre. An abundance of free parking is available on site and the venue is easy accessible from the motorways and Manchester Airport, and just a short 7 minute walk from the rail/tram station. Again we will have a waiting/warm-up area separate to the exam room and refreshments will also be provided.

For those travelling from afar there are plenty of hotels in Altrincham including: Best Western Cresta Court, Travelodge Altrincham and Mercure Bowden Hotel.

Rules & Regulations

1. Only Basic Steps may be danced in the Preliminary grade and Grades 1, 2 & 3.
2. The number of bars of music to be danced to for all Reels, Single or Hop Jigs, Light Jigs, Slip Jigs, Heavy Jigs and Hornpipes is **40**.
3. St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Garden of Daisies, Job of Journeywork, King of the Fairies, Three Sea Captains, and Jockey to the Fair must be performed in a traditional style and manner.
4. The same set dance **must not** be performed in more than one of the Grades from 9 to 12.
5. A dancer must take all grades in order, beginning with Grade 1 - the Preliminary grade is optional.
6. A candidate may **only** attempt a maximum of 3 consecutive Grades at any one sitting.
7. A three month period must elapse before the next grade is attempted.
8. Candidates must be able to adequately demonstrate practical and theoretical knowledge of all ceili dances as per "Ár Rincí Céilí" as specified in the syllabus for Grades 5 -12 inclusive. The candidates must not be asked to teach these dances.
9. Dance costumes should not be worn.
10. All candidates must produce previous certificates & scoresheets to the examiner before attempting further grades. Failure to bring the needed documentation from prior passing reports may result in disqualification since candidates must take and pass all grades in order.
11. No fee refunds will be provided. If you do not pass one exam, you cannot take the next.
12. The same examiner may not examine in the same class for a period of 3 years. This also applies where a regional authority or group of classes hold the examinations. e.g. Applications for 2019: Examiners may not have examined in years: 2018, 2017 or 2016.
13. Examinees must be examined by at least FOUR different examiners up through Grade 10 (and at least 2 up through Grade 6).
14. There will be opportunity on your entry form to declare all previous examiners so that we can allocate an examiner that you have not been examined by previously.
15. Grade 11 may only be attempted by candidates at least 16 years of age.
16. Grade 12 may only be attempted by candidates at least 17 years of age.
17. A special application form and certificate/diploma will apply for Grades 11 and 12.

Examinations are CLOSED to spectators, only candidates and teachers will be permitted to enter the exam room. Staff will enforce this rule. Please do not attempt to observe.
