NEW LOCAL RULE FOR ALL SOUTHERN ENGLAND REGION FEISEANNA

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED £2 ADMIN FEE PER DANCER FOR THE 2 WEEKS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE
ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED UP TO & INCLUDING THE DAY OF COMPETITION BUT MAY BE SUBJECT TO
A £5 ADMIN FEE PER DANCER IF PAID ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION

- 1 Ages to be taken from **1st January 2012**.
- 2 The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 3 Lodgement of entries implies that you acknowledge and accept all of the Rules of An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha and the Southern England Regional Council plus the additional rules listed below, relating to the Feis.
- 4 Entries will only be accepted from Schools registered with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha, subject to the discretion of the Feis Secretary.
- 5 "Novice Rule" Basic steps as defined by the Southern England Regional Council will be adhered to for all Novice Grade Competitions.
- 6 **ALL** Grade Competitions are OPEN to all Regions.
- 7 A Dancer may only compete in **one grade** for each dance with the exception of dancers who are intermediate and wish to compete in the Open Championship, Preliminary Championship or Premier. Competitors must dance in their own Age Group for Solo Competitions.
- 8 Dancers should have their Competitor Registration Card with them in the event of a query as to their Age Group.
- 9 Where there are five or less entries for a Novice, Primary or Intermediate competition, results will not affect their grading. **A solo competition cannot be held with only "1" competitor.**
- 10 Novice is a dancer who has not placed **1st, 2nd or 3rd** in a Novice Grade competition or any medal in a higher grade for that particular dance.
- 11 Primary Grade is for dancers who have not placed **1st or 2nd** for that particular dance in any Age Group.
- 12 Intermediate Grade is for dancers who have not placed **1st** for that particular dance in a particular Age Group, or who has won a Premier competition, Preliminary Championships or Open Championship.
- 13 A Panel of Three Adjudicators will judge all Championships from Under 8 upwards. All Championship cups are perpetual and recipients will be responsible for any loss or damage and for the safe return in adequate time to be presented to subsequent winners.
- 14 All decisions of the Adjudicators are **FINAL**.
- 15 Any Solo, Ceili or Figure competition or Championship may be moved to another hall at the discretion of the Feis Secretary to ensure the safety of the dancers and their families as well as to accommodate delays to timetable.
- 16 The Feis Committee accept no liability for loss or damage to personal property.
- 17 New entries may be taken on the day of the Feis at the Discretion of the Feis Organiser..
- 18 No Smoking, eating or drinking in any of the halls, except in designated areas.
- 19 **Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition.**
- 20 **Photographs taken at awards ceremonies are permitted, however these must be for your own use and not used for public display purposes, unless permission has been obtained.**
- 21 Objections against any breach of the above rules must be made in writing, and signed, to the Feis Secretary and accompanied by a fee of £25.00, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 22 Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus, proof of which may be required, will be exempt from this ruling
- 23 **Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children**, at all times, whilst attending the Feis.
- 24 **Dancers must be fully dressed at all times. No changing allowed in competition areas.**
- 25 All Novice and Primary dancers may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt & top or simple dress for girls and trousers, shorts and t-shirt or shirt for boys) in competitions up to and including the Under 12 Age Group. Make-up will not be permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group Worldwide. Failure to comply with this rule may lead to disqualification from the competition.
- 26 An Coimisiun has ruled that from 1st January of each year, that **no block, en pointe**, stationary or moving be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group Worldwide. **The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to Toe Walk from 1st September.**
- 27 If parents have any constructive comments to make about any aspect of Feiseanna, these would be welcomed by the council and should be put in writing. It should be noted that anonymous correspondence cannot be dealt with.
- 28 A dancer is only eligible to enter a preliminary championship if they have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an open championship from 1st January in the previous year or within the current year. If there were 5 or fewer dancers in the open championship result, the dancer will still be eligible to enter a preliminary championship. A dancer is not eligible to enter a preliminary championship if they are a current medal holder from Oireachtas Na Cruinne. If a dancer wins two preliminary championships within the current feis year, commencing 1st January of that year, they are no longer eligible to enter a preliminary championship in the rest of the current year and until December 31st of the following year. Competitors can only dance in either Preliminary or Open Championship, they may not compete in both. Intermediate competitors can dance their grade dances and either the Preliminary or Open Championship.
