6. <u>Preliminary competitions:</u> results will be taken from the first two rounds in all age groups from 8 – 9 up to 16-17 inclusive. Teachers MUST tick the appropriate box on the entries to ensure that competitors are registered in the Preliminary competitions.

Preliminary Grade – Rules/Eligibility:

A dancer who meets the following criteria is eligible to enter the Prelim competition at Oireachtas Chonnacht 2024: -

- Preliminary Championships (8-9 years upwards) are confined to competitors who have not been placed in the top 3 in an Open Championship judged by 3 or more adjudicators.
- Dancers must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than two times in the current year, however, if there are 5 or less in a preliminary championship the dancer is still eligible to compete in preliminary championships.
- The dancer must not have qualified for the World's in 2024 or 2023. Dancer must have not recalled in the actual Championship at the All-Ireland's 2024 or 2023.
- Dancers having won 2 Preliminary Championships may not compete in any mean grad competition for the remainder of the year, however, if a dancer has won only one preliminary championship they may continue to compete in mean grad (with the exception of the dances they have won the prelim championship with).

- Craobh Rince Céilí Céilí teams must dance Part A only of any Eight Hand dance from Ár Rince Céilí.
- 8. Craobh Rince Céilí (4-Hand Mixed) Teams must dance Part A of any four-hand dance from Ár Rinci Ceili 2014. Boys competing in a 4 Hand Ceili Championship may NOT compete in any 8 Hand Ceili Championship if both teams are going forward to Oireachtas Rince na hEireann and Oireachtas Rince Na Cruinne
- Birth Certificates The correct date of birth must be completed on entry. Birth certificates must accompany entries from competitors who have not previously submitted a birth cert. Short form birth certificate will suffice. No photocopies or baptismal certificates will be accepted.
- 10. Dancing Costumes Please inform your pupils that full costume including socks and shoes must be worn on stage for all presentations. Failure to do so will result in the dancer or team being excluded from presentations.
- Teachers must produce ID badges to gain free admission to the venue.
- 12. Running Order of Dances Under 7, 7 8 and 8 9's will dance the Reel first. All other age groups will dance the heavy round first.

FAMILY COMPETITION FEE: 220 euro. Teachers may apply to Comhairle Chonnacht for the family fee, listing all the names of competitors and the competitions they are entering. Only immediate family may be included, i.e., siblings.

Rules of the Oireachtas

- Comhairle Chonnacht is <u>NOT</u> responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
- Objections, if any, should be made in writing to the Secretary and accompanied by a fee of 30 euro. Objections must be lodged prior to the result and will be dealt with after the Oireachtas. No meetings will take place during the Oireachtas.
- 3. The Comhairle will, as far as is practicable, provide stage surface suitable for dancing. However, the comhairle cannot accept any liability for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer.
- Dress code in accordance with An Coimisiún ruling will be observed. Dancers will not be permitted to walk around in their underwear.
- Health & Safety: In the interests of children's health, hairspray or any form of sprays are not allowed to be used in the hall at any time; before, during or after competitions.
- 6. Only competitors, Comhairle members and teachers will be allowed side-stage.
- 7. Photography: As per An Coimisiún rules, "The use of any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability of capturing a dancer's image while in motion is strictly forbidden". Any person found in breach of this rule will be asked to leave the championships.
- Make Up: as per An Coimisiún ruling, make-up including false eye lashes is not permitted on any dancer under the age of 10 years.
- Qups & Tiaras: All perpetual trophies/cups/tiaras awarded in 2023 must be returned to Comhairle Chonnacht on the stipulated date in good condition. Solo or Team competitors failing to comply with this rule will be refused the right to compete at this year's Oireachtas until a fine of 200 euro is received by the Comhairle. The holder and his/her parents shall be responsible for any loss or damage to a trophy/cup while in the holder's possession. The holder's teacher shall be responsible for ensuring that the trophy/cup is returned in good time and in good condition.

CLRG MEDIA POLICY

Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g., mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden.

Comhairle Connacht has appointed an official photographer for Oireachtas Rince Chonnacht, who will take photographs and videos of competitors, competitions and presentations. Such photographs and videos may be subsequently used for the marketing and promotional purposes of the organisation including the publication of such photographs on the official website www.cirg.ie, www.cirg.ie, www.cirg.ie, <a href="https:

Comhairle Connacht may also appoint other agents during the course of the Championships for special promotional projects and reserves the right to permit suitably accredited photo-journalists to take photographs on a case-by-case basis. Should any dancer or dancer's parent or guardian wish to be excluded from any of these photographs, please contact any member of the Oireachtas Committee with relevant details.

PLEASE NOTE: Other than the photographs taken by the official photographer, authorised agents of **Comhairle Connacht** or accredited photo journalists, all photographs captured at the event including images of competitors and presentations may only be taken for **personal use**. They may not be redistributed, sold, lent or passed on to third parties. They may also not be used for commercial purposes or used in any publication or posted to any website without the express written permission of **Comhairle Connacht** and the parents or guardians of all dancers included in any particular picture.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT will not be permitted inside the competition rooms with the exception of individuals that have a valid CLRG photo pass. Attendees are not allowed to bring zoom lenses greater than 70mm inside the dance events, and no individuals will be granted access to take photographs on or near the stage during the competitions.

MEDIA APPLICATIONS: Accredited journalists may apply for event access and photo passes by contacting Comhairle Connacht All applicants will be required to complete the necessary paperwork and be compliant with our child protection policy and all rules of Comhairle Connacht and of CLRG.

Ignoring or failing to comply with the above may lead to expulsion from the premises.
