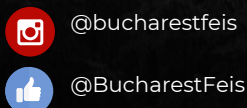

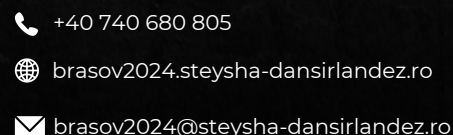

# RULES FOR SOLO QUALIFYING CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Dancers resident in Continental Europe and Asia of Prelim/Open standard are eligible to compete in the Qualifying Championships – Oireachtas Rince 2024. Entries are only accepted from Teachers registered with RCCEA/CLRG for 2024 - 2025.
2. Regional Council of Continental Europe and Asia Oireachtas 2024 follows the same rules and directions for Step Dancing, Ceili Dancing and Figure Dancing as the **Worlds**. Please see the 2024 World Syllabus for all of these General Rules.
3. Three adjudicators will adjudicate the Qualifying Championships.
4. Qualifying for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne will be determined by this panel of adjudicators, who will take into account the rulings with regard to the number of qualifiers permitted as laid down by the rules of An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha and any other rules pertaining to qualifying for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne.
5. The number of qualifiers from the corresponding competitions in the RCCEA Oireachtas shall be as follows:
  - a) In the case of the Senior Men's Championships, there shall be seven (7) where the number of participants is twenty or fewer, plus one additional qualifier for each five (5), or part thereof, in excess of the first twenty competitors;
  - b) In the case of all other Solo Championships (from Under 10 and up), there shall be five (5) where the number of participants is twenty or fewer, plus one additional qualifier for each ten (10) or part thereof, in excess of the first twenty competitors.
6. In the case of Qualifiers Championships, competitors will dance 48 bars of music in the Reel and Heavy Jig and 40 bars of music in the Slip Jig and Hornpipe. Championships will commence with the Heavy Dance Round.
7. Dancers up to U16 will dance three at a time for their heavy shoe rounds and two at a time for their soft shoe rounds. Dancers from Over 16 upwards will dance two at a time in both solo rounds. Dancers in the Non-Qualifying Mixed Championships U6 through U9 will dance three at a time in all their rounds.
8. Only Set Dances included in the Oireachtas program 2024 (available on the CLRG website) may be performed in Step Dancing Competition at the Qualifiers. Please note we offer a choice of set dances in either jig tempo or hornpipe tempo for our qualifiers. \*Under 10 Boys & Girls – Recall dancers must dance a jig set only in line with An Coimisiún ruling.
9. Minimum metronomic speeds are outlined there too.
10. A dancer who does not complete their Championship will not be awarded a place at the Oireachtas.
11. There will be a 50 % recall when entries exceed 15 dancers in the Solo Qualifying Championships.



12. All teachers should notify and explain the rules and regulations for dancing at the World Qualifiers to their dancers. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that a teacher and their pupils understand these rules, and undertake to abide by them.

13. Placement in the RCCEA Oireachtas will not restrict a dancer from competition in a Preliminary Championship outside of their region. [RCCEA June 2018].

14. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability of capturing a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g.: Mobile Phone, iPad, standard camera, video camcorder with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden during competitions. Photographs taken at awards ceremonies are permitted. However, these must be for your use, and not for public display purposes unless permission has been obtained.

15. Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled. **Competitors must also wear full dancing costumes and shoes for award ceremonies.**

16. The **dress code** in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of the safety of young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the venue scantily dressed.



# RULES FOR TEAM QUALIFYING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1. Age concessions in team competitions.** A team in a competition for céilí or figure dancing may include dancers who are under the minimum age limit stipulated for the competition subject to the following conditions which must be strictly adhered to. A teacher may include a number of underage dancers not exceeding 50% of a céilí team or 50% of a figure team without seeking prior permission but must inform RCCEA in writing, prior to the Oireachtas and furnish the names and date of births of the underage dancers. These dancers may also compete in a team in their own age-group in either a competition for mixed teams or a competition for girl's only teams. Alternatively, they can compete in both mixed teams and girl's only teams in a higher age group.
2. A teacher may include more than the 50% under age dancers in a céilí team or 50% in a figure team as stated above providing they (a) notify RCCEA in writing with the names and dates of birth of the under-age dancers furnished with the application. (b) The number of underage dancers does not exceed 75% of the team i.e. 3 in a four hand, 6 in an eight hand, 9 in a twelve hand and 12 in a sixteen hand. (c) The underage dancers (up to the 75% maximum) may compete in both mixed teams and girls' only teams in the higher age-groups, but subject to rules 3 and 4 below. (d) Where the number of underage dancers allowed dance in a higher age group exceeds 50% in céilí or 50% in figure, only 50% in céilí or 50% in figure may also compete in teams in the lower age group. treated as if these were separate competitions.
- 3. A dancer may only compete for one school** of dancing in either solo championships, team championships or both.
4. The members of a team must be pupils of the same school of dancing.
- 5. Each team in the Qualifying Ceili Championship** must have learned and be prepared to dance one eight hand. The chosen dance must be performed in accordance with "Ar Rinci Ceili". Only lead round, body and part A or B of the dance must be performed, excluding under 10 age groups.
6. A 'mixed' team for the Continental Europe and Asia championships can consist of two boys and six girls in an eight-hand dance and two boys and two girls in a four-hand dance. It is not permissible for a girl to dance as a boy or vice versa.
7. Boys competing in a four-hand Ceili Championships may not compete in any eight-hand Ceili Championship either in their own age group or an older age group.
8. A girl may compete in a girl's only céilí championship even if she is a member of a team in a competition for mixed teams.



9. A dancer must not be a member of more than one team in the same competition except in the case of an unforeseen emergency and then only with the permission of RCCEA.

10. For the **Figure Dance** competition each team must consist of not fewer than eight and not more than sixteen dancers. The dance must be performed in accordance with rules presented in the syllabus for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne.

## **RULES FOR NON-QUALIFYING MIXED CHAMPIONSHIPS, ADULT CHAMPIONSHIPS & SUBSIDIARY COMPETITIONS**

1. Three adjudicators will adjudicate the Under 6, Under 7, Under 8, Under 9 and Adult Championships.

2. In **Under 6 Championships** competitors will dance 32 bars of music in the Reel and Light Jig.

3. In **Under 7 Championships** competitors will dance 40 bars of music in the Reel, Light Jig and Single Jig.

4. In **Under 8 Championships** dancers will dance 40 bars of music in the Reel and Single Jig plus any traditional set dance.

5. In **Under 9 Championships** dancers will dance 40 bars of music in the Heavy Jig and Reel plus any traditional set dance.

6. Make-up (including false eyelashes and tanner on the face) is not permitted for dancers, in either solo or team competitions, up to and including the Under 10 age group - i.e. no makeup to be worn in the under 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 age groups.

7. **Adult Championship** competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won first, second or third prize in Open Championships in the last two years and are not competing at the Qualifying Championships in 2024. Adults are required to dance 32 bars of heavy dance jig or hornpipe and 32 bars of reel or slip jig. The third round will be a choice of traditional set dance.

8. **RCCEA Trophy competitions** are subsidiary competitions for the RCCEA Oireachtas. They do not go under the Open Platform Status. They are restricted to dancers registered with RCCEA.





9. **RCCEA Trophy competitions** are open to all dancers who have not been previously placed in the top five in Open Championships and are not competing at the Qualifying Championships nor Adults Championships in 2024. These competitions are open to the Primary and Intermediate levels. **Dancers taking part in the under 6, 7, 8 and 9 championships may not take part.** Dances will be played at Intermediate speeds.

10. In RCCEA Trophy competitions dancers have a choice of reel/slip jig, heavy jig/hornpipe. Dancers will perform 32 bars of their chosen dances dancing two at a time.

11. **The Champions Step About competitions** are open to Preliminary/Open dancers in both heavy and light shoes. Dancers will dance 16 bars in heavy shoes and/or 16 bars in light shoes. These are two separate competitions, in mixed age groups. All dancers start at the back of the stage. This is a great extra competition for dancers competing in the Qualifiers.

## OFFICIAL CLRG/RCCEA RULES

1. The event will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha.
2. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
3. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
4. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
5. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions. No approaching the judges or requesting feedback after the competitions.
6. Age will be taken as of 1st January 2024 (whatever age you turn this year, in 2024 you dance under that age. E.g. date of birth is 29th May 2014, you dance Under 10 all year long).
7. Dancers should have proof of age in the event of a query into their age group.
8. Order and quiet must be kept in the halls, particularly while competitors are dancing.
9. Food and drink must not be consumed in the hall.
10. Smoking is not permitted in any of the competition halls, nor in the vicinity of the access doors or ventilation windows of any of them.



11. Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled. **Competitors must also wear full dancing costumes and shoes for award ceremonies.**
12. The **dress code** in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of the safety of young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the venue scantily dressed.
13. Female adult dancers participating in competitions entitled 'adult competition' and/or 'adult grade competition' (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier not less than 70.
14. Team dances (four hands and upward) must be performed as per the Coimisiún handbook "Ar Rinci Ceili".
15. By entering competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public Internet archives or any other feis entry/results system as may replace it.
16. During all competitions comprised in this syllabus, **ONLY** the official feis photographer is permitted to take photos. Photography is permitted during all awards ceremonies.
17. An Coimisiun has ruled that from 1st January each year, no block, en pointe, stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.
18. The Feis organisers cannot accept any liability for injury sustained or for the loss or damage to property or belongings which may occur while on the event premises.
19. No refunds will be made.
20. All CLRG rules will apply in the case of a missing rule on this syllabus.
21. Following the GDPR rules, any personal information the dancers or their guardians provide to the Brașov 2024 team will only be used to communicate information pertaining to their attendance at this year RCCEA Oireachtas and Brașov Feis and STEYsha School of Irish Dance & RCCEA will not use or forward this information to any third party.

# TRAVELLING TO BRAȘOV



## ARRIVING BY PLANE

### FLYING VIA BUCHAREST

**Bucharest Airport** train to North Train station: exit the **airport** on the upper floor arrivals. The train platform is right outside, on the left side, in a suspended platform with a green covering. The train runs every 40 minutes and the ride takes approximately 25 minutes. You can pay for your trip by card on the train, or purchase **an online** ticket at the terminal ticket kiosk. The price is 5.5 lei (1.11 euro).

**Bucharest Airport to Brașov** – for transfer arrangements, please contact **Ro Team Tour**. Include the name of the traveller(s), and flight details, and mention that it is for Brașov Oireachtas 2024. They will take care of the rest.

**Train Bucharest – Brașov** – there are more than 30 trains between the two cities daily. The average trip duration is between 2.5 hours to 3 hours. We recommend this as the fastest way of getting to Brașov. On your way back to Bucharest, we recommend you opt for trains that start their trip in Brașov, rather than the ones coming from further away. You can check the train schedule and buy online tickets.

### FLYING TO BRAȘOV

**Brașov-Ghimbav Airport** is a new airport, so more international flights are expected to be added to it throughout the year.

### Arriving by car

We recommend you reserve extra time should you wish to drive there, as traffic might be heavy in some areas, depending on the time of the day. Parking is available at the venue, as well as in some of the event hotels. However, parking within the city is not always available.

### Staying in Brașov

The venue, Centrul de Evenimente Lux Divina has its own 3-star hotel, which we will prioritise for bookings by our international guests until June 1st 2024.
