Dear Friends

We are very happy to invite you to our first feis organized by Scoil Rince Coiscéim. The feis is being held in the capital city, Prague, which is well connected with most of the European cities. The nearest airport is Prague Vaclav Havel Airport (10min drive) with regular low costs and standard flights. It is also the first feis in our region of the new school year – a perfect opportunity to try out the new material.

The venue is a large modern sports hall located on the western side of Prague, very close to the airport. There is a big, covered parking facility under the sports hall. There is a large main hall as well as results area in the hallway. Practice area and changing facilities are provided as well. The feis will run on two floors in one day. We are excited to offer grade competitions for all levels and age groups including adults, as well as open and adult championships. We also offer a brand-new competition – Team Treble Reel.

There will be trophies for all first places and medals for runners up in the trophy dances, championships, traditional set dances and treble reels. Sashes will be awarded to the top three dancers in the championships.

Please note there will be a cap of 300 dancers for the feis.

We have been the Open Status by CLRG so not only CLRG-registered dancers may come to our feis – everybody is warmly welcome!

We are looking forward to seeing you all in Prague in September and wish the very best of luck to those competing at our feis!

Travel Information

Venue: Sportovní centrum Řepy, Na Chobotě 1420/16, Praha 17, Czechia

Car park is located under the sports hall. Please respect road signs when parking.

Distance from the Prague Vaclav Havel airport: 10 min drive by car

For taxi use the Bolt or Uber app or Local TAXI companies (cheapest to order on phone, it is strongly advised not to take the taxi from the street or a taxi stand).

For public transport in Prague please use app PID Litacka (purchase of tickets possible).

The nearest public transport stop is "Sportovni centrum Repy" (only 1 bus line) directly in front of the venue or "Sidliste Repy" (buses & trams) 5 minute walk from the venue.

Entries will open 1st June 2026 and close 13th September 2026. Please note there is a cap of 300 dancers at our feis. Late entries on the day will be allowed to already registered dancers only.

Dancers' numbers will be available for collection by teachers or school representatives - the fee for the entire school must be paid beforehand.

Rialacha NaFeis - Feis Rules

1. The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha.
2. Entries will be accepted from persons currently registered with An Coimisiún.
3. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
4. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
5. Age will be taken as on 1st January 2026. Whatever age a dancer turns this year in 2026, s/he will dance under that age all year long, e.g. if a dancer's date of birth is 5th May 2013, he/she dances under 13 in the year 2026 or 11-13). Evidence of age may be requested, therefore dancers from Mainland Europe should have a valid ID with them in the event of a query as to their age
6. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
7. Beginners Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st 2nd or 3rd prize in any competition for that particular dance (please refer to the grid). In Beginners Grade competitions only basic steps may be performed.
8. Primary Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st 2nd or 3rd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance other than in Beginners Grade.
9. Intermediate Grade competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won 1st or 2nd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance in Intermediate under the same or higher age limits. If a dancer in Continental Europe and Asia wins in Intermediate, they advance to the next level for the rest of the calendar year. Teachers can move dancers back at their own discretion at the start of the next calendar year.

10. For all Beginner, Primary, Intermediate the 32-bar method (down the line) will be applied. In Beginner/Primary/Intermediate trophy competitions and first feis special 16 bars are required. All Open Championship dancers (except adults in Adult Championships and U8 age group) will be required to dance 40 bars of music in the reel and jig and 32 bars in the slip jig and hornpipe. In the Adult Championships and U8 Open championships dancers will be required to dance 32 bars of music in both their dances in the Round 1 and Round 2 and Round 3 (U8 only).

11. Team Treble reel competition is freestyle, and the topic is BACK TO SCHOOL. The dancers will be required to dance to 32 bars of music in Reel time at speed 113 in teams consisting of 2 or 3 dancers.

12. Open and Adult Championships will be judged by three adjudicators. If there are more than 12 dancers in any competition, it will go to recall. Dancers who wish to compete in rounds only solo competitions may do so. If they do not dance a set dance they will be excluded from the Championship result, but they will be judged in the solo rounds.

Round 1: choice of heavy jig or hornpipe (reel for the U8)

Round 2: choice of reel or slip jig (light jig for the U8)

Round 3 (recall): single jig (U8), choice of traditional or modern set dance (U10), modern set dance (U12-O23), traditional set dance (adult championships)

Adult championships are open to dancers of Intermediate and above level who have never won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in an Open Championship and are not participating in a full Open Championship. Please note these Championships have been created for dancers who started Irish Dancing as ADULTS.

13. 4/6/8 Hand ceili competitions must be performed in accordance with the An Coimisiún handbook "Ar Rinci Ceili" and are subject to the rules applied at Oireachtasi.

14. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún, the organisers may at their discretion cancel or combine competitions with insufficient entries.

15. Order and quiet must be kept in the hall, particularly while competitors are dancing.

16. Traditional Set Dance competitions are a choice out of 7 traditional dances: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Jockey to the Fair and Three Sea Captains. If a dancer wins first place in any traditional set dance competition, s/he moves on the next level in all 7 traditionals.

17. Provided that dancers are not disturbed by flashlights or the like, photography or video recording by persons other than official feis photographers is allowed during Beginners and Primary competitions and during all award ceremonies. During Intermediate and Open/Adult Championships competitions, this is reserved to any official feis



photographer if present on site.

18. **Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled. It can happen that the competitions will start 30 minutes ahead of scheduled time.**
19. The Feis organisers cannot accept any liability for injury or loss or damage to property while on the premises.
20. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions.
21. The dress code in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed. Changing areas will be provided.
22. All Beginners and Primary dancers of all age groups may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt and top/blouse, simple dress for girls and ladies, trousers and t-shirt/shirt for boys and gents). Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.
23. Costume Length: Length of costumes must adhere to principles of modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may ask a competitor to change into black tights (of a denier not less than 70 per cent) in order for the dancer to continue in the competition. When wearing body suits with skirts (commonly known as black-out attire) black tights (of a denier less than 70) must be worn. Effective date: 1st February, 2020 For details of approved costume features, please refer to the Costume Rules on www.clrg.ie.
24. Female Adult dancers participating in competitions entitled (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier no less than 70. CLRG ruling March 2015.
25. An Coimisiún has ruled that from 1st January each year, that **no block, en pointe**, stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. **The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.**
26. By entering in competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public Internet archives.
27. No refunds will be made unless the feis is cancelled.
28. Music will be played at the recognized An Coimisiún speeds of Mainland Europe.
